FSSD Behavior Consultant, Autism Consultant and Occupational Therapist will present this session on ***how to have a successful summer*** with your special needs children. Topics include: Staying on schedule, creating routines/procedures for the home setting, social opportunities and incorporating independent work & activities. They will also present academic resources to include: apps and other internet resources to use at home to promote academic skills, typing programs, talking to your child's teacher (getting a list of sight words, what does a school day look like and how can you "re-create" a similar structure at home). The final topics include summer Programs geared towards sports/recreation as well as those geared towards the creative arts.
